Minutes

Meeting conducted at Sportsman's Hall

Members present: Carol Abbanat, Eric Bonnicksen, Martin Fine, Ken Harper, Jack Mallinson, Rich Mason, Davey McNeil, Dave Rogers, Dennis Staller

The meeting was called to order by President Eric at 8:00 am

Breakfast with Santa: The grills need to be picked up. Eric will check with the fire station to confirm dates for pickup. Dave suggested the day before the event, and warned that they must be transported on a lowboy trailer because of their weight. Carol offered her trailer, and assured that it was low enough. Dan will manage the food handling in the kitchen and has that planned. Davey advised that the sausage will be cooked at the Pizza Factory. Four Interact students will assist. After some discussion it was decided that we should plan on 250 to 300 attendees. Margaret advised us that the crafts supplies are exhausted, and that she will have to acquire more.

Rotary meeting signs: Eric believes that we should not yet commit to the purchase of another sign announcing the meeting times and locations. He thinks it is too early to make that decision. Jim suggested putting the information on the web site.

After some discussion Eric determined, and the members present concurred, that we should change the evening meeting time from 6 pm to 6:30. Some members have businesses that close at 6, and the change will help them make meetings.
